Northeast (NY, MA, VT, NH) Silage-

21L90- Strictly silage, Leafy, floury grain, excellent milk per ton on test (85 day)
23A71- Performs well in fertile soils, very good seedling vigor in cool soils, top quality silage in a 86 day corn (86 day)

27B16 & 33Å16-Very high yielding, heavy ears, Good dual purpose corn, will respond well to higher fertility (88 day & 92 day)

34C17- PROVEN time and time again to have great yields in unfavorable conditions, Good ear flex, excellent seedling vigor and growth (93 day)

43L96- Tall leafy, low lignin, silage only, highly digestible silage with great milk per ton testing (98 day)

Grain-

o7B98- New variety with great yield potential in northern climates, good "stay green" (78 day)
21B11- New variety with excellent seedling vigor, Very good yield potential (85 day)
26B78- A great corn that produces long girthy ears, husk separation to speed up grain dry down (88 day)
34C17- PROVEN time and time again to have great yields in unfavorable conditions, Good ear flex, excellent seedling vigor and growth (95 day)

58G54-Good yielder, medium statured plant that stands well in fall, Good dry down (96 day) 49K70- Reliability in a great yielding corn, good stress tolerance, slow dry down (103 day)
